

## Living at Home



# Custodial Services at Home

Support Services up to 8 hrs/day (Home Health Aide) or more if paid for out of pocket

Long-term

Support for ADLs at home with services that come in to help, such as bathing & toileting.

Aspire? Yes

### Skilled Services at Home

Home Health RN, PT, OT, ST up to 3x/week

Short-term

Usually post-hospital to help with recovery.

Aspire? Yes

### Hospice Services at Home

Medications, DME, Nursing and home health support as needed

Long-term

Life expectancy is six months or less, qualified by two physicians.

Aspire? No



### Independent Living

Usually RN or LVN during certain daytime hours, meal delivery sometimes available. Long-term

Live in apartment type facility, but independently. Personal Care Home falls into this category.

Aspire? Yes



### **Assisted Living**

Some nursing care available, meal delivery or cafeteria available.

Long-term

Live in apartment type facility with privacy, but with occasional help available.

Aspire? Yes



## Living in a Facility



### Nursing Facility – Custodial Care

Around the clock nursing care

Long-term

Live in facility with more of a hospital type atmosphere, long-term.

Aspire? No



### Rehabilitation Center (SNF)

Around the clock nursing care

Short-term

Short stay for recovery, usually post-hospital. Wound care, PT, OT, ST; Can lead to custodial care in the same facility.

Aspire? Not until discharged from facility



### Memory Care Facility

Patient level of care varies according to need.

Long-term (not going home)

Progressive care for patients who are likely going to get worse.

Aspire? Case-by-case basis. Call facility to see if Aspire is permitted.



### Long Term Acute Care

Around the clock nursing care with daily access to MD's & other services. Weeks to months (average is 25 days)

Critical illness that may get better. Supports use of breathing machines.

Aspire? Not until discharged from facility.



### **Hospice Facility**

Around the clock nursing care with access to physicians and other services on a daily basis Long-term (not going home)

Life expectancy is six months or less, qualified by two physicians.

Aspire? No
